Terms and condition of application

For the purposes of the provisions contained hereunder, “the School” shall mean or denote The Red & Yellow School. “You” and “Student” shall mean or denote the student and/or the parent/guardian as the case may be and unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Please note: Applications for all Full Time Certificate, Advanced Diploma and Degree programmes close on 1 February 2026. Our amazing team of Programme Co-ordinators will be in touch with details around Registration and Orientation Week.

1. General

1.1. As a student at the Red & Yellow, you shall at all times maintain a high standard of behaviour and academic diligence, that adhere to the School’s code of conduct and student policies, and not conduct yourself in a manner which causes prejudice to or brings the name of the School into disrepute.

1.2. You acknowledge that you have familiarised yourself with the prospectus of the relevant programme for which you have applied to register and declare that the information. provided in this form is accurate and complete.

1.3. You accept that the School reserves the right to monitor your attendance and in the case of your extended absence (more than two consecutive days, and for Full Time students only) due to illness or injury, you will be required to submit a medical certificate.

1.4. You accept responsibility for the replacement or repair of any damage or loss caused by you to the property of the School. You accept that the School is not responsible for lost or stolen property and that any of your personal belongings brought onto the premises should be insured in your personal capacity. You hereby indemnify the School against any claim in this regard

1.5. When you participate in School activities, including external visits which may take place from time to time, it shall be at your own risk. The School shall not be held liable for any injury or other damage sustained by you in the course of such participation. You hereby indemnify the School against any claim in this regard.

1.6. You shall at all times comply with your financial obligations to the School in accordance with the provisions of this application.

1.7. You confirm that you are in a state of good mental health and that you or your guardian shall fully disclose to the School details of any condition/disease/handicap immediately upon becoming aware of the same. The School shall treat any such disclosure as being confidential.

1.8. All/any work originated and/or undertaken by you during the period of your registration at the School and all/any intellectual property rights related thereto shall be deemed to be the property of the School. You hereby cede all your rights, title and interest in and to such work and such aforesaid intellectual property rights to the School. The School reserves the right to cede, reassign or otherwise deal with these rights at its discretion.

1.9. You accept that the School shall from time to time undertake assignments from outside companies, and that you may be requested, as part of your training, to work on these assignments. You accept that the School shall be entitled to charge professional fees for these assignments and that you shall not be entitled to financial remuneration for my participation. You accept that all such work is highly confidential and will not be disclosed outside of the School.

1.10. You accept that the formal hours of practical tuition at the School for Full Time programmes are 08:00 to 16:30, Monday to Friday, and that the respective Heads of Departments retain the right to change the curricula and/or periods of practical tuition beyond the formal tuition hours. You undertake to abide by and comply with such extensions as aforesaid.

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1.11. You understand that a qualification related to your completion of any programme at the School shall be awarded to you only if you have met the required academic standard and evaluation criteria of the School, and only if you have fulfilled your financial obligations in terms of this application and the agreement constituted under it. In accordance with the above, the School expressly reserves its right to withhold any such qualification until all the financial obligations referred to have been properly fulfilled.

2. Deposits, fees, method of payment

2.1 Upon written acceptance of a student to study at the School a non-refundable registration fee is required for each programme. The final date for such registration and payment of the registration fees for the 2026 School year is 31 January 2026 for Full Time programmes. Students who have not paid their fees by this date will not be eligible to start their studies in February 2026.

2.2 This registration fee is to reserve your place in the programme and will be forfeited should you elect not to attend. Note: The non-refundable registration fee does not form part of the tuition fees.

2.3. Should you elect not to continue or complete your studies, withdraw or have your enrolment or registration terminated for any reason whatsoever, you will be liable for (a) 50% of your course fees if this happens in the first Semester; and (b) 100% of your course fees if this happens in the second Semester.

2.4. Where your tuition fees are payable in instalments, your failure to pay any single instalment in full and timeously will result in the full amount owing becoming due and payable immediately.

2.5. You agree that the School shall be entitled to recover from you all legal costs incurred in order to enforce its rights under this contract, including, but not by way of limitation, attorneys and own client fees and collection charges and all tracing charges, and that the School reserves the right to withhold programme/module results should there be any default in payments according to this agreement.

2.6 The Red & Yellow School is a privately run institution and receives no state funding. The majority of income is generated by student fees, corporate-sponsored bursaries and remunerations from commissioned projects.

2.7. Fees for international students are the same as for South African students, except that the Extended Credit Payment Plan is not applicable.

2.8. In the event that the student elects to make payment via two instalments (for Full Time programmes) or the scheduled extended credit plan, the School at its absolute discretion may require additional personal information before approving either credit facility and any acceptance by the School of this application shall be subject to such provision and its acceptability thereof and also may require the person responsible for the Student's account to sign a debit order mandate.

2.9. NOTE: In the case of 2 & 3 year programmes, fees may increase by up to 10% annually, or in accordance with prevailing economic circumstances.

3. Personal information

3.1. In terms of the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (POPI), a "Responsible Party" (the School) has a legal duty to process a "Data Subject's" Personal Information (your personal information) in a lawful, legitimate and responsible manner. In order to discharge this duty, the School requires your express and informed permission to process your Personal Information.

3.2. In the event of you refusing to provide the required consent, the School reserves the right, in terms of POPI, to process your Personal Information without your consent under any of the following circumstances where:

3.2.1. such processing and use of your personal information is necessary and within the ambit of its operations in order to give effect to a contractual relationship as between you and the School;

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3.2.2. such processing is required in terms of the applicable laws of the Republic of South Africa, or

3.2.3. such processing is necessary to protect the legitimate interests of the School or a third party.

3.3.
